All further cable cars and lifts run daily from 9.00am to 4.00pm.

The ski slopes are closed each day from 5.00pm to 8.45am! You are not permitted to ski or stay on the slopes during these times.

On Wednesdays the pistes may be used by "First Track" participants from 7.30am.

Exceptions in Serfaus
The Mittel, Süd and Wald downhill runs are closed from 6.00pm (except on Wednesdays: Mittel downhill and tobogganing run are closed 5.00pm – 6.00pm, open from 6.00pm – 11.00pm for "Adventure Night").

Exceptions in Fiss
The Ladis, Poschi and Winkl downhill are accessible daily from as early as 8.30am, the Möseralm downhill and Winkl downhill for night skiing is open from 5.45pm until 10pm. The Möseralm descent is open for tobogganing from 5.45pm until 9.30pm during the toboggan evening.

Piste maintenance and snow-grooming vehicles with winch cables

We occasionally need to deploy piste maintenance machines on the slopes when they are still being used by skiers. Please ensure you keep a safe distance from such machines in the interests of your own safety. Please heed acoustic and visual warning signals at all times! After pistes close at the end of the day winch cables from piste maintenance devices present a potential hazard. The cable car operators accept no liability for accidents! Please note that in the case of persistent snowfall, groomed slopes may once again become snowed over prior to opening so that they may not always be completely frozen. As a result, moguls and piles of snow may form shortly after the ski slopes are in use.

Closure of pistes and avalanche blasting

For safety reasons, avalanche blasting may take place if large amounts of fresh snow have fallen. Detonations usually take place in the early hours before the start of regular ski operations. If there is a particularly large volume of new snow, avalanche blasting may also have to take place while the slopes are being used by skiers. The affected areas are then closed for skiing! Watch out for information at stations and terminals!

Backcountry skiing

If you intend to go skiing outside the secured area you are advised in the interests of your own safety to find out about the risk of avalanches, any planned avalanche blasting and weather conditions from the cable car operators.

Tobogganing

Please do not use the ski slopes. Use the tobogganing run or the signposted tobogganing slopes.

Skating accidents

Please report the type and location of the accident to the nearest lift station or terminal, or contact the mountain rescue services directly.

Inspections and fraudulent use

Admission checks are carried out at the cable car valley terminals using automatic scanners. Please follow the instructions of the staff and use the ticket inspection machines properly. On-the-spot inspections take place in the ski area. Therefore, you should always carry your ski pass with you. Any incident of fraudulent use or bypassing of the scanners shall result in immediate confiscation of the ski pass. We reserve the right to report the offence to the police. Anyone caught in the inspection zones without a valid ski pass shall be required to pay a fine set at twice the allday ticket rate. A receipt showing that the fine has been paid can be used as a ski pass on the same day. Please note that under the Austrian railways liability act, only customers with a valid ski pass are covered for insurance purposes. Do not buy any ski passes from unauthorised vendors – such ski passes may be blocked! Furthermore, you are committing an offence by doing so! Kindly note that for admission control purposes a reference photo shall be taken of the lift pass holders when they pass through a turnstile equipped with a camera for the first time. Lift personal shall compare this photographic image with photos taken each time the user passes through a turnstile equipped with a camera. The reference photo shall be deleted immediately upon expiry of the lift pass validity; other photos shall be deleted no later than 30 minutes after the user passes through a turnstile.

NEWS.

THE NEW SERFAUS UNDERGROUND TRAIN IS READY:

The new Serfaus underground train is probably the most modern and, moreover, the highest altitude hovertrain in Europe. Following the extensive modernisation of the underground stations, the new set of carriages was finally added. The set of carriages is 45 metres long and equipped with the latest infotainment system. Wheelchair and pram-accessible entry and exit options as well as widened access doors and accessibility throughout the entire railway ensure accessibility. The system can transport 3000 people per hour and the interval between trains has been reduced from ten minutes to nine.

ZIRBENHÜTTE ADDITION:

The Zirbenhütte terrace has been extended with a roofed section. Particularly when temperatures drop and during bad weather, our guests benefit noticeably from this improvement in quality.

SKI PASS MACHINES AT THE VALLEY STATIONS:

When you book your ski pass online, you can collect your ski pass 24/7 right from the new machines. The machines also allow you to return your keycard.

EXTENSION TO KINDERSCHNEEALM

WINKL DOWNHILL ILLUMINATION:

Starting this season, the descent linking floodlit Bertas Kinderland to Fiss will also be brightly lit. Guest can therefore now also take the downhill from Kinderland to Fiss during Kids Night on Tuesdays evenings.

TRADITIONAL SKI HUT EVENING IN LASSIDA:

Adventure Night features a traditional ski hut evening with live music and classic delicacies.

TOBOGGAN AND FONDUE EVENING:
